## Submitting Fixed Wired Broadband Subscription and Availability Data

These are the steps to submit a filing of Fixed Wired Broadband Availability and Subscription Data in the BDC system, along with links to other resources for information on specific steps.

- 1. Have you accessed the Fabric? If not:

- 2. If you don't have one, get a Username, Password, and FRN from the FCC's Commission Registration System.

- 3. Log into the BDC system

- 4. From the Entity Selection page of the BDC system, select an FRN for which you wish to submit BDC data.

- 5. Fill out the Entity Information page.

- 6. From the Submissions Dashboard, click Create Submission and select Biannual, or select an existing submission.
